♦ NOMINATION & APPLICATION PROCESS

Nomination	When officially nominated by their home institution, students have to be ready for application documents.
Application	Applicants must submit soft copies of the required documents by email. All soft copies must be scanned (PDF file) from the original documents. The complete application documents must include the following: ① Completed Application Form ② Self Introduction and Study plan ③ Letter of recommendation from the sending institution. ④ Official Academic Transcript in English ⑤ Certificate of Enrollment in English ⑥ Photocopy of Passport (valid until at least 6 months after the end of exchange term) ⑦ ID Photos (JPG/JPEG format, color photo taken within the last 6 months, full face without hat, front view against white or off—white background) ⑧ Health Insurance Certificate (must cover all medical costs and possible accidents during student's study period at Inje. Insurance Certificate must state coverage period and destination/territorial scope)

◈ ON-CAMPUS HOUSING (INTERNATIONAL HOUSE, 양현재)

• Exchange students should be staying at International House only for international students. Rooms would be randomly assigned by dormitory staff and each room in the dormitory has no an en suite bathroom. There is a shared bathroom/shower room on every floor, which has compartment that the students can protect their privacy.

On-Campus Housing

- Room Type: Double room, 2 students in 1 room
- Room Facilities: Single bed, wardrobe, desk, chair, air conditioner, heater, wifi access, 220 volt outlets, bedding (blankets, sheets, and pillows)
- Dormitory Facilities: Conference room, studying room, discussion room, laundry room, communal kitchen
- * When you enter the dormitory, you have to pay a deposit of 30,000 KRW for bedding set / dormitory pass. This deposit will be returned when returning them back.

♦ VISA / IMMIGRATION

- · Required Documents
- ① Visa Application Form (Form No. 17), passport, a photo in a standard format, fee
- ② A copy of Business Registration Certificate (or Registration Number Certificate) of a respective education institute
- ③ Standard Acceptance Letter (issued by the dean/president of the university)
- 4 Original copy of documents proving your financial ability to support yourself

Visa to Korea

- When submitting a parent's bank statement, family relation certificate is required to submit.
 - (5) Recommendation letter issued by the head of your university
- ⑥ Documents proving that you are an exchange student (official documents of the host university, exchange student agreement between universities)
- 7 Documents proving that you have completed at least one semester (Proof of enrollment from a university)
- If all the documents above prepared, you can get started with your visa issuing process at Embassy of the Republic of Korea in your country.
- * The head of Korean diplomatic missions abroad may request for



	additional documents depending on the condition of the country of
	residence/jurisdiction if it is deemed necessary for visa evaluation. It is
	strongly recommended that students plan ahead and apply for their visa
	as soon as they receive their acceptance packages. Without a valid visa,
	students may have to cancel their exchange semester at Inje.

♦ ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Insurance	All exchange students are required to submit a copy of insurance certificate that covers all medical costs, emergencies, and accidents during the period of their study at Inje. Without a valid insurance certificate, student's enrollment at Inje can be cancelled. It is important that students are covered by their insurance from their arrival date to departure date. If not, students must buy a policy from an insurance company arranged by Inje after their arrival.
Buddy Program	There are Inje students who help international students adjust smoothly into the life and culture of Korea. OIA organizes different field trips, parties, Korean language tutoring, and many cultural activities. Once exchange students confirm their arrival dates, make sure that they have to let OIA know in advance. Then one of OIA staff or Korean buddy students will be at the Gimhae airport or the Busan/Gupo train station to take them to Inje.

You must stay in a dormitory separately prepared by Inje University for quarantine for 14 days after entering the country. It will also charge a small fee for isolation. For smooth quarantine, it is not allowed to find a place and quarantine students arbitrarily.

- Must wear a mask and do a self-diagnosis link before entering the building. https://ijis.inje.ac.kr/covid19/main.aspx
- Stop for a moment in front of the camera at the entrance of each building to measure your body temperature. A student who has a fever of 37.5 or higher cannot go inside the building.
- After the temperature measurement, you can get a sticke and put it in a visible location



* If the risk of infection will be increasing due to the re-proliferation of COVID-19, which threatens the health and safety of Inje University students, Inje University is always considering the transition to non-face-to-face classes.
