You must stay in a dormitory separately prepared by Inje University for guarantine for 14 days after entering the country. It will also charge a small fee for isolation.

• Must wear a mask and do a self-diagnosis link before entering the building. https://ijis.inje.ac.kr/covid19/main.aspx

• Stop for a moment in front of the camera at the entrance of each building to measure your body temperature. A student who has a fever of 37.5 or higher cannot go inside the building.

• After the temperature measurement, you can get a sticke and put it in a visible location
