Tuition fees	All exchange Incoming students coming from partner universities are exempt from paying any tuition fees at Ca' Foscari University.
Application procedure for exchange students after Home University's Nomination	Incoming Students must upload online within the deadline (see above): - One passport-size photo - Transcript of records - Learning agreement - English or Italian certificate (B2 level) - Copy of a valid ID or passport. Visa requirements (if relevant)	All Non-European students must have a valid VISA. In order to apply for it, they may ask an official invitation letter to be submitted along with the other documents to Italian embassy.
